The Informant! (R): Matt Damon shines in this comedy from director Steve Soderbergh, about a corporate executive who becomes a whistleblower to the FBI. He quickly lets his newfound importance go to his head and begins thinking of himself as a budding superspy. Scott Bakula and Joel McHale co-star. The DVD includes deleted scenes; the Blu-ray also has audio commentary and a digital copy of the film.

Everybody's Fine (PG-13): Robert DeNiro, Drew Barrymore and Kate Beckinsale star in this drama about a man trying to reconnect with his grown children.

Cirque Du Freak: The Vampire's Assistant (PG-13): Sideshows and vampires get mixed together in this story of a teenager who is drawn into a traveling carnival filled with supernatural secrets. The cast includes John C. Reilly, Salma Hayek and Willem Dafoe. DVD extras include deleted scenes and featurettes; the Blu-ray has even more deleted scenes.

Dead Snow (Unrated): Zombies? Trouble. Nazis? Trouble. Nazi zombies? Uh-oh. This fast-paced, gory and at times goofy horror-comedy from Norway follows a group of college students who go for a vacation in the Alps and accidentally thaw out some Nazi corpses that just won't stay dead. The two-disc DVD and Blu-ray versions include plenty of extras.


The Box (PG-13): What could have been a fine half-hour *Twilight Zone* episode is bloated to feature length for this movie about a couple given a sinister proposition: they will become rich if they push a button that causes someone, somewhere, to die.

Blank Generation (Unrated): The New York punk scene of 1980 spawned this drama, with a cast including punk star Richard Hell, Carole Bouquet and Andy Warhol. It's a virtual time capsule of that period. Extras include live performances by Richard Hell and the Voidoids at famous club CBGB.

Trailer Park Boys: Countdown to Liquor Day (R): A Canadian comedy series about dysfunctional lowlifes was the basis for this fun, raunchy movie, about three ne'er-do-wells who wreak havoc after getting out of prison. Extras include deleted scenes, featurettes and an alternate ending.

The Damned United (Unrated): This comedy-drama is entertaining even if you don't care about English football (soccer). It follows the turbulent tenure of a manager of championship team Leeds United. Extras on the DVD and Blu-ray include commentary, deleted scenes and featurettes.
