## SUPERNATURAL: SEASON 14 (Blu-ray)

The Winchester brothers' harrowing journey into the heart of darkness continues as *Supernatural* enters Season Fourteen. Sam and Dean have matched wits with monsters, demons, Heaven and Hell. But in Season Thirteen, the Winchesters stumbled upon a terrifying alternate universe — an apocalyptic world where they were never born — all while training Jack, the son of Lucifer, and trying to save their mother, Mary Winchester. The final battle with Lucifer and the archangel Michael altered the Winchesters' lives forever ... and created an even greater threat for Sam and Dean. The boys are back and willing to risk everything for their loved ones, in all 20 thrilling new adventures, including an historic 300<sup>th</sup> episode, with a Winchester family reunion that will never be forgotten.

## BULL: SEASON THREE (6-DVD) Paramount + CBS DVD

After Bruce Springsteen and the E Street Band's marathon "Rising Tour" came to an end in 2003, Clarence Clemons felt like he needed a break. So he packed up his saxophone and voyaged to China, where he could be a more-or-less nameless traveler in a foreign land. *Who Do I Think I Am* continued to follow Clarence after China and document his transcendent awakening, and then tragedy struck. While in Florida, Clarence suffered a stroke and passed away. Featured are interviews with President Bill Clinton, Joe Walsh, Nils Lofgren, and Jake Clemons, former band mates, friends, and close family members. *Who Do I Think I Am* highlights Clarence's life as a musician and member of the E Street Band, while also presenting another side of Clarence that not many saw when he was away from bright stage lights. It's an intimate portrait of a man who searched for enlightenment and meaning at the unknowingly final years of his life.

The Authority is seeking Qualification Statements from Trade Contractors who have a demonstrated experience in the construction and implementation of similar work in terms of scale and complexity as required for the Terminal E - Logan International Airport. In accordance with Massachusetts construction manager at-risk requirements, MGL Chapter 149A Section 8, Qualification Statements are being requested from trade contractors capable of performing the following classes of work: Painting  
The contract includes the following scope of work: Expansion of Terminal E to accommodate seven (7) new Gates; substantial renovation to existing Terminal E Bagrooms, Ticketing hall and Custom Border Protection area; Roadway modification; Apron work and all the supporting utilities. The estimated cost of the trade contractors' portion of the Project is approximately \$5,097,700 and the construction duration is approximately thirty-six (36) months.
