Quick Hits & Clips: All Time Low, Vanilla Fudge, Antony And The Johnsons, Let Me Run, Adam Freeland

- Jack Barakat, the amiable guitar player in the pop-punk quartet All Time Low, has teamed up with Glamour Kills Clothing to release his own line of clothing named "JAGK." The line was launched Tuesday, January 20th, and it is being exclusively sold only at Glamour Kill's web store. Barakat worked closely with Owner/Head Designer Mark Capicotto to ensure that the line was made to fit the ideas that he had envisioned. The official release of the line includes three items: two t-shirts and a hoodie.
- ABC has announced the upcoming release of Vanilla Fudge's When Worlds Collide on CD and DVD (set to hit stores on March 10th and February 10th, respectively). An American band that first came to prominence in 1967 and recorded a number of albums between '67 and '70, when they split. Vanilla Fudge also enjoyed success in the American singles chart with a slowed down arrangement of the Supremes hit You Keep Me Hangin' On. Formed by keyboardist Mark Stein and rhythm section Tim Bogert (Bassist) and Carmine Appice. The final member was guitarist Vince Martell. This DVD features core members Tim Bogert and Carmine Appice alongside newer members Teddy Rondinelli on guitar and Bill Pascali on keyboards. In this performance from 2004, the band run through key Vanilla Fudge songs including Take Me For A Little While, Season Of The Witch, She's Not There and of course You keep Me Hangin' On. There is also a cover of the Rod Stewart Hit Do Ya Think I'm Sexy which Carmine Appice wrote whilst a member of Rod Stewarts band during the seventies.
- Antony of Antony and the Johnsons asked his friends the Wachowski Brothers to work with him on a video for his new single "Epilepsy is Dancing." They, in turn, invited painters Tino Rodriguez and Virgo Paradiso to create costumes and a mystical environment and choreographer Sean Dorsey and his dancers to bring the dream sequence to life. Antony's artistic partner Johanna Constantine stars as herself in the role of "Deer Monster." The video was lit and shot by the up-and-coming directors of photography, Chris Blasingame and Banker White, and produced by Jim Jerome. The production team collectively named themselves AFAS. - New Brunswick, NJ's Let Me Run are streaming their newly released debut album on Punknews.org
- The directors Gold have just finished their video for Adam Freeland's Daft Punk/Obama mash up. It was shot in Los Angeles last month using stop motion animation, a posse of little plastic dudes and a lot of patience. Gold is Richard Farmer and Sinuhe Xavier. Farmer has co-directed many award-winning ads and music videos, most recently winning two MTV Video Music Awards for his direction of Gnarls Barkley's "Run" video.


