
ALBUMS OF THE YEAR 2014

Piano trios, don't cha just love 'em! Reports that the past decade's deep infatuation with the format was beginning to fade would appear to be somewhat premature given the results of the *Jazzwise* **Albums of the Year Critics Poll 2014**, where three, count 'em, piano trios are placed firmly in the top five positions! Chick Corea's astonishing *Trilogy* has been acclaimed as, "probably his finest work since he left ECM in the late 1980s" and has left a big impression on all who've heard it. At number two, Phronesis' highly kinetic live album of new material, *Life To Everything*, cements them as today's preeminent Scandi-Brit piano trio as they continue to expand their horizons in Europe, America and beyond. But it was the Michael Wollny Trio's dark, subconscious journey through dreamworlds, *Weltentraum*, that took pianist and composer Wollny's increasingly inspired vision to a new level of performance and imagination, and grabbed a well deserved Album of the Year accolade in our annual poll, where 10 points are awarded to first place down to one point for 10th place. In his native land Wollny became the first German jazz pianist to make it into the national Top 50 chart with *Weltentraum*, while the trio's galvanic, seat-edge performance at May's Cheltenham Jazz Festival is still being talked about. Congratulations also to Christine Tobin and her superb interpretations of Leonard Cohen's songs, *A Thousand Kisses Deep*, which nailed the number three spot, and trumpeter Ambrose Akinmusire's sparkling, *The Imagined Saviour Is Far Easier to Paint*, which made number four and proves that the Blue Note label is still coming up with key works in its 75th anniversary year. And for the second year running, Miles Davis tops the Reissues/Archive chart – but when Columbia turn out archive projects as magnificent as this Fillmore set, who's to argue? Jon Newey
