KEITH LOWELL JENSEN: CATS MADE OF RABBITS

"I was in a truck stop in the South when I first saw one," begins comedian Keith Lowell Jensen when explaining the rabbit soft totems fast replacing jackalopes as popular roadside attractions. "They are very realistic-looking cats, like taxidermied house pets, only softer, because you realize that they're not cats—they're actually rabbits stitched together in cat form. And somehow we're okay with that—taking rabbits and making cats out of them."
