In 2004, after many years adrift, Tennessee singer/songwriter/pianist Hans Chew took up permanent residence at the decrepit Clermont Hotel in Atlanta, Georgia.

Armed with little more than a piano, an old Royal typewriter, a handful of New Orleans LPs, and a stack of ragtime, blues and boogie-woogie sheet music, Chew's journey to master the elements of rock and roll piano had begun.

He checked out two years later with a handful of songs and moved to New York City. These songs would become his 2010 debut album, Tennessee & Other Stories, which received four stars from Rolling Stone magazine and was heralded by Uncut as one of the top 25 albums of the year.

He's back with new album, Life & Love, described by one US critic as "Dixie-fried rock 'n' roll awesomeness... a barn burning smoker of a record that's simply irresistible".
