POKÉMON DETECTIVE PIKACHU ★★★★★

Start looking for clues when Pokémon Detective Pikachu (Warner Bros. 4K Ultra HD + Blu-Ray + Digital Code) may not take its wonderfully inexplicable premise as far as it could have, but this unconventional adaptation should catch most -- if not all -- of the franchise's fans (Japanese Anime). But this is a live-action adventure with Pikachu rendered to look like a soft, furry yellow plush toy with red rosy cheeks voiced by none other than Ryan Reynolds! This exciting 4K package also includes "Detective Mode" on the BD version!!! The story begins when ace detective Harry Goodman (Paul Kitson) goes mysteriously missing, prompting his 21-year-old son Tim (Justice Smith) to find out what happened. Aiding in the investigation is Harry's former Pokémon partner, Detective Pikachu: a hilariously wise-cracking, adorable super-sleuth who is a puzzlement even to himself. Finding that they are uniquely equipped to communicate with one another, Tim and Pikachu join forces on a thrilling adventure to unravel the tangled mystery. Chasing clues together through the neon-lit streets of Ryme City - a sprawling, modern metropolis where humans and Pokémon live side by side in a hyper-realistic live-action world - they encounter a diverse cast of Pokémon characters and uncover a shocking plot that could destroy this peaceful co-existence and threaten the whole Pokémon universe. ALICE, SWEET ALICE ★★★★★

Horror at its best has been restored and this lost masterpiece, Alice, Sweet Alice (Arrow Blu-ray) made in 1978 has been restored in a 2K High Definition presentation to give you yet another does of the shivers!!! A young Brooke Shields meets an untimely end in this religious-themed proto slasher par excellence from director Alfred Sole.
