Hitch Hike To Hell (Arrow Video) has been restored from the newly discovered 35 MM print to a 2K scan and is now presented



in H D (Arrow Video Blu-ray). This rare horror story can be compared to Hitchcock's "Psycho" but made in 1977. The creeper stars Robert Gribbin and Russell Johnson. Yes, there's murder in the sun and mother obedience is on his mind! Be careful who you hitch a ride with!

All roads lead to terror in Hitch Hike to Hell, the delightfully sleazy cautionary tale from cult director Irvin Berwick (Malibu High, The Monster of Piedras Blancas). Howard is a mild-mannered momma's boy whose job running deliveries for a cleaning agency affords him a lot of time out on the road. It's not until he picks up young women running away from home that he transforms into a twitching, homicidal maniac, hell-bent on meting out punishment for their transgressions. Can the cops put a stop to Howard's

demented spree before he claims yet another victim? Influenced by the depraved crimes of the likes of "Co-ed Killer" Edmund Kemper, Hitch Hike to Hell is a bonafide American nightmare from the vaults of legendary exploitation producer Harry Novak (The Child, Toys Are Not for Children). 


