NEW DVDS FROM NEW YORK DOLLS AND DEVO



For the first time ever on DVD, comes the definitive document of the New York Dolls, the one and only record of all of the band together at their peak.

It features never seen before footage of the Dolls live on stage, hanging out together and rare interviews.

In the early 70's, rock photographer Bob Gruen and his wife Nadya purchased a portable video recorder. In a period of three years, they shot more than 40 hours of New York Dolls footage. This feature length documentary, All Dolled Up, follows the band from their early performances in New York in clubs such as Kenny's Castaways and Max's Kansas City, intercut with revealing interviews, backstage banter and full performances.

This DVD is released by Wienerworld on January 30.

Devo were one of the best, most innovative and credible bands to emerge from the US new wave movement.

They were also one of the most successful too - the single Whip It was one of the biggest hits of the 80s and saw the flowerpot wearing eccentrics move into the mainstream.

Their brilliant live is captured in the DVD, Devo Live 1980, released courtesy of Wienerworld on January 30 2006. It features Devo at their peak, just as Whip It was launching them to international stardom.

Wienerworld also release three DVDs featuring guitar heroes, Larry Carlton and Steve Lukather Band, Larry Coryell, Badi Assad and John Abercrombie and Johnny 'Guitar' Watson - Live in Concert.

In February, for the first time ever on DVD, comes two fantastic live concerts featuring Big Country from Grugahalle Essen recorded on March 15 1986 and Biskuithalle Bonn on September 6, 1991. Also released is a 1987 Hamburg concert by John Hiatt and Jimmy Barnes recorded in 2001.
