

WORLDS BEST MUSIC DVDS

Thriving independent Wienerworld can expect blossoming sales this spring with the release of a series of DVDs featuring major pop music icons

Wienerworld's Anthony Broza, Managing Director of the independent boutique music label, is particularly enthusiastic about two March releases on the Wienerworld Classic label. According to Broza both Elvis '56 and Tom Jones Duets are being stocked in depth at a number of leading retailers and Wienerworld is pitching them strongly at the Mother's Day market with a very competitive dealer price of £4.08.

Elvis '56 has already sold strongly at full price and captures the time when the reign of the King had just begun. The DVD features a wealth of footage of Elvis performing on both the Dorsey Brothers Show and the ED Sullivan Show along with numerous rare clips of the star at the peak of his charismatic youth performing the likes of Love Me Tender and Blue Suede Shoes.

Mothers are sure to be flinging their smalls at the TV screen for Tom Jones Duets which finds the Welsh crooner on fantastic form performing alongside a wealth of stars including Tina Turner, Dusty Springfield, Dionne Warwick, Gladys Knight and Chaka Khan. Among the 20 hits on Tom Jones Duets are It's Not Unusual and You Can Leave Your Hat On.

Already winning considerable critical acclaim Wienerworld is expecting strong results from the release of Bob Dylan 1975-1981 Rolling Thunder And Gospel Years on April 24, a comprehensive 240-minute DVD that finds the hugely influential musician at a crossroads in his remarkable career.

In 1975 Dylan took to the road as the Rolling Thunder Revue which culminated in the infamous The Night of the Hurricane benefit concert at Madison Square in aid of



the wrongly convicted boxer Rubin "Hurricane" Carter. The DVD features Hurricane's first interview in 30 years and finds band members Ramblin' Jack Elliott, violinist Scarlet Rivera, bassist Rob Stoner, and Ms. Jacques Levy revealing the inside stories of their time on the road with Dylan. Three years later Dylan found God and reinvented himself as The Entertainer. Broza describes the comprehensive 240 minute DVD as "a sure fire hit with all Dylan aficionados" and is understandably excited about its release. Broza is equally enthusiastic about what he describes as "a real coup", Leo Sayer Live - One Night In Sydney. With Sayer having recently enjoyed

a number one hit for the past few weeks with the remix Thunder In My Heart, the singer's profile is as high as at any point in his 40-year career.

The 99-minute DVD, which is set for release in May, finds Sayer performing all his major hits in front of an avid Australian audience. Tracks include Giving It All Away and rather appropriately The Show Must Go On.

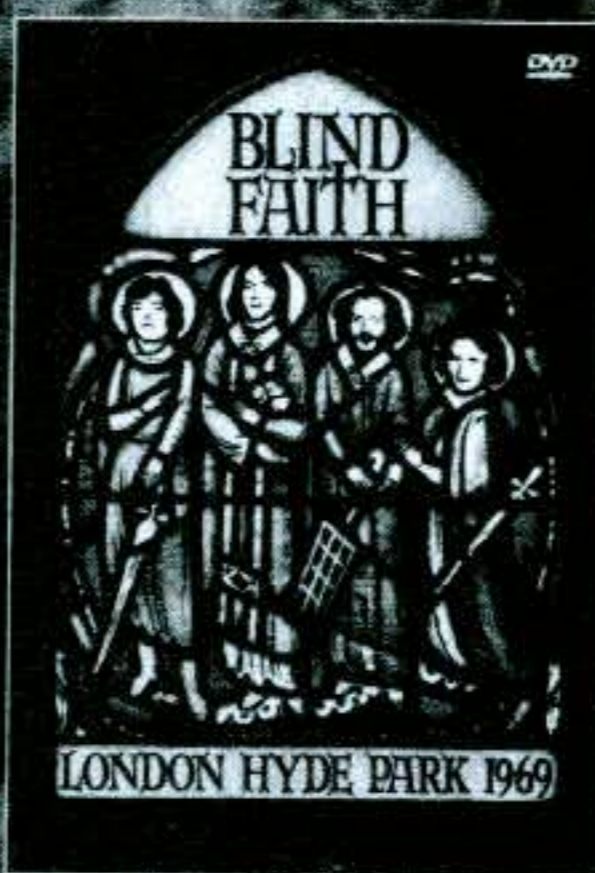

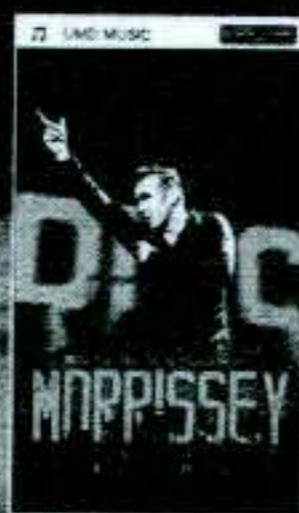
