BAD BRAINS—LIVE CBGB 1982 SCREENING

Considering the modern-day hipster fetishization of virtually every punk/post-punk band to emerge in the late '70s/early '80s, it's a little surprising that D.C./NYC proto-hardcore unit Bad Brains hasn't been reassessed and raised to the level of, say, Television, at least. There's still time, though: The new concert film, *Bad Brains—Live CBGB 1982*, captures H.R. and Co. during their legendary three-night stand at the historic club (when it was still making history). This premier screening, at Park Slope's excellent Southpaw, will also be the only screening in the region: Though the pic will be available on DVD, it will not have a theatrical run beforehand. And while it may not be the same as seeing the band live—much less seeing them live in '82—it's the closest you're gonna get, and it's guaranteed to be great. *—Michael Patrick Nelson*
