... Jet are set to release their new single 'Bring It On Back' at the end of November. The single will include three new tracks - 'Janie Jones', 'Where Are All My Good Friends?' and 'I Only Like You When I'm High', the three tracks were recorded in Barbados.



... The original line-up of <u>Dinosaur Jr.</u> are to release their first album of new material since 1989. However, bassist Lou Barlow, formerly of <u>Sebadoh</u> and The Folk Implosion, believes it will be a one off. Recorded at guitarist J Mascis' home studio in Amherst, Massachusetts, the currently untitled album will be released in 2007.

... <u>Elvis Presley's</u> appearances on "The Ed Sullivan Show" will be chronicled on a 3-disc DVD set "Elvis Presley: The Sullivan Shows." To be released end of November, the Andrew Solt-produced collection features all three shows on which the King performed in their entirety, including appearances by other guests and the original commercial breaks.

... A new <u>Prince</u> track, "*Song of the Heart*," will be found on the soundtrack to the upcoming animated film "Happy Feat." The cut, which features slap bass, piano and horns, was written specifically by Prince for the film, which boasts the voice talents of Elijah Wood, Nicole Kidman, Hugh Jackman and Robin Williams.

The <u>Nirvana</u> concert film "*Live! Tonight! Sold Out!*" will make its DVD debut in November. Originally issued on VHS in 1994, the release was conceived by Kurt Cobain as a way to anthologise Nirvana's quick ascent to rock superstardom but was not completed until after his 1994 suicide.
