Despite highly encouraging muscular moments (see the grizzly-bear-sized breakdowns on "I'll Go Until My Heart Stops" and "Elysium"), the guys too often fall back on the cloying emo-chorus-out-of-nowhere songwriting paradigm that has hijacked the world of heavy music. 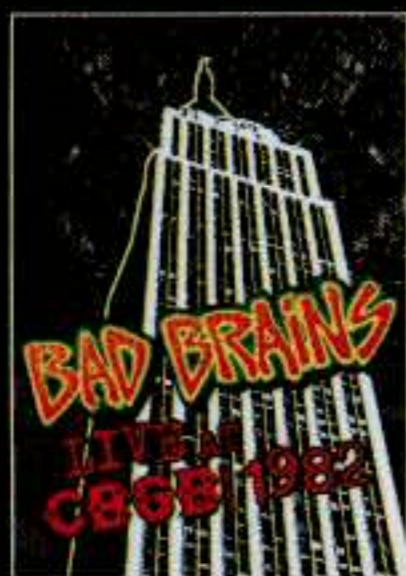
Harvey Milk ANTHEMS

do revere them. The makers of this highly limited and exquisitely designed DVD clearly count themselves among such devotees. A true labor of love, it collects three and a half hours' worth (44 songs) of live footage from '93 to '05, showcasing the trio at its atavistic best: destroying guitars, using sledgehammers as instruments, and beating gongs with flaming drumsticks.
