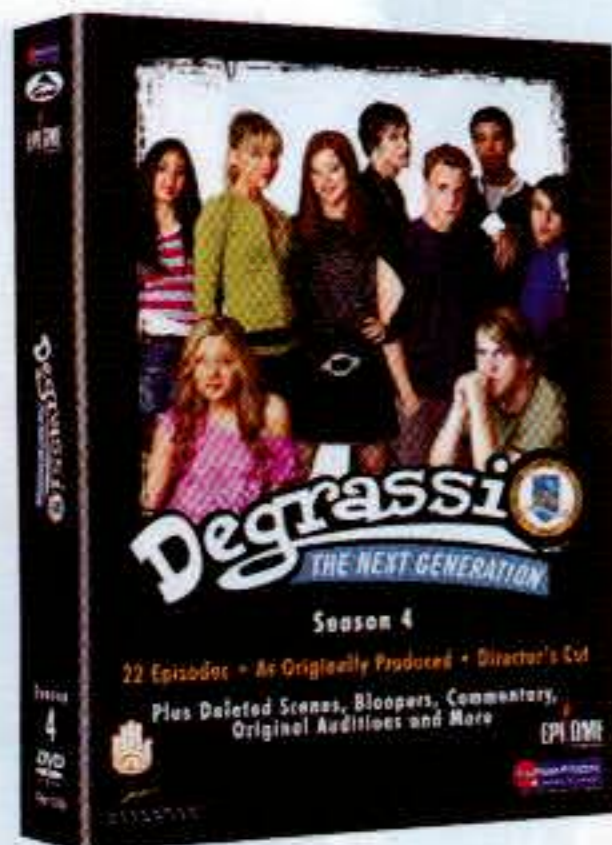

Fox's luck on DVD

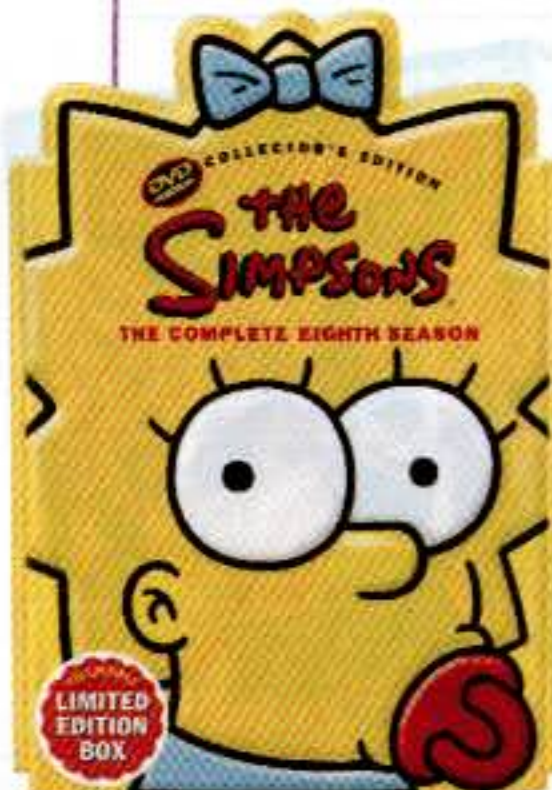
