



U.K. Subs, Warhead: 25th Anniversary Marquee Concert

In London on October 24, 2002, the British punk band U.K. Subs was celebrating its 25th anniversary at the famous Marquee. It's that historical concert we can see here in a very good performance of 68 minutes. The concert started a little slowly with a few weaker tracks, but after that, the fast beat took the stage. We can find 21 tracks including the classics "New York State Police", "Tomorrow's Girls" and "Down On The Farm". Even if in my opinion the U.K. Subs didn't record many good albums, it's particularly interesting to rediscover them 25 years later. And the concert is presented with the big lighting and sound, which is making it maybe one of the biggest shows they did in their entire career. The DVD also contains a very good interview for a big total of more than 2 hours of material. With the surround sound 5.1 in bonus, this is definitely an excellent DVD that is offered to us, a DVD that will remind good memories for the oldest ones and will make the youngest ones discover another real punk band of the British wave of the late 70's.
