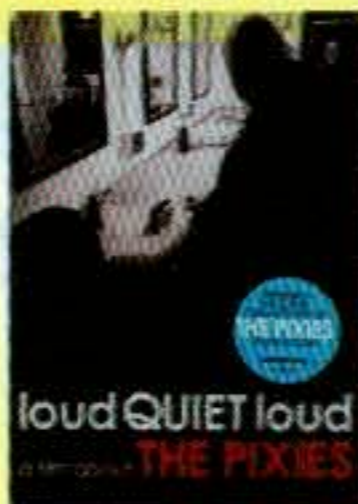

SURF STRONGER: THE SURFER'S WORKOUT

While training for a triathlon, lifelong California surfer Scott Adams realized that he was also surfing stronger and better than ever. From there, Adams (who's certified by the National Strength And Conditioning Association as a physical trainer and coach) teamed up with several other experts to develop *Surf Stronger:*

The Surfer's Workout. The DVD guides you through a multilevel workout with exercises that target key surf muscles and simulate waveriding movements. The program focuses on improving flexibility, increasing power, and developing core strength.
