

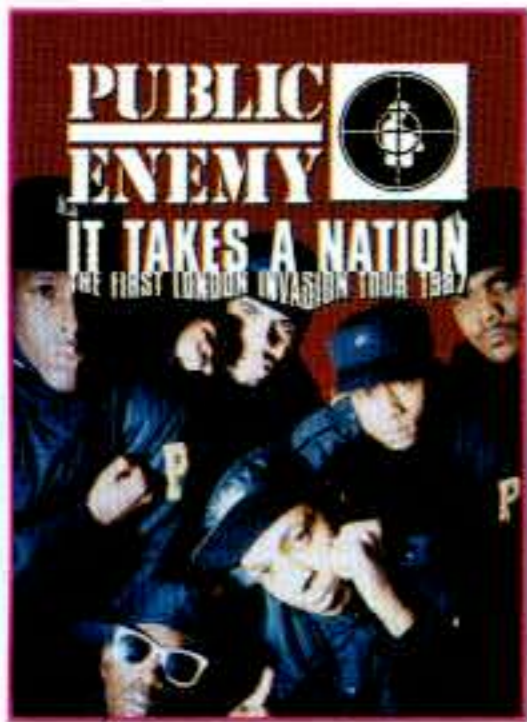


**TUNER BATTLE ROYALE

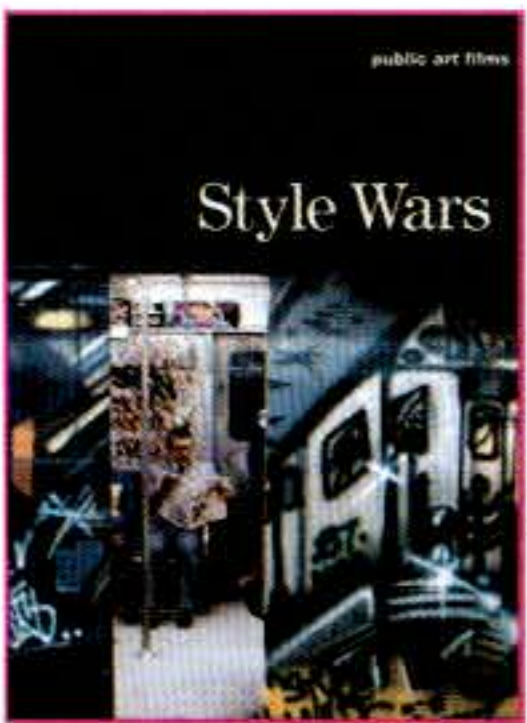


PUBLIC ENEMY IT TAKES A NATION: THE FIRST LONDON INVASION 1987

Style Wars is the award-winning, real-life action-adventure about the epic battle of New York's graffiti writers to get their art up on the city's subways... the rolling art extravaganza that would change the world of art and culture forever. The city is decaying, and there's a war on. Kids 12-20 are rocking the city from its orbit with new letters, sounds and moves. If you are one of those guys carrying around a camera and documenting your scene, you have to watch this DVD! When I got

my live broadcast VHS tapped copy in 1983, this documentary took over my life and just had major answer impact to my intrigue with a culture I had become involved with.

This new deluxe double DVD set, with over three hours of bonus documentary and artistic material, including powerful new interviews with Style Wars participants and special guest artists, conducted by Joey Garfield (director of Breath Control: The History of the Human Beatbox) as well as by the filmmakers. Also included are outtakes and extremely rare archive hip hop footage from the 70s and 80s, and 200 "Hall of Fame" photographs of classic graffiti art subway cars. Extra special eye candy is added with "Destroy All Lines," a continuous, 30 minute full screen loop of all 200 cars traveling through the frame.

New music is contributed by Definitive Jux artists EI-P, RJD2, and Aesop Rock, plus Mr. Wiggles, Kimson "Angola Red" Albert, David Chalfant, and Darryl Jenifer.

I was originally going to make this a review about the DVD. I watched the DVD before I got the press release, but I just pulled the press release to get some info to help me write the review. Lets just say the release was less than word perfect so I felt the need to review it instead. Destroy Entertainment, the DVD's distributor, is an AOL/Time Warner affiliated company so they should at least have access to some writers. The first big error that jumped straight out at me is that the person (not sure if it's a boy or girl) who wrote this misspelled the Gumball founder, Maximillion Cooper's name—though only once. He/she did get it right the other time. For this alone I'd probably fire someone. He/she did the same for "actor/race car driver" Adrien Brody (and I'm not even sure I've gotten it right
