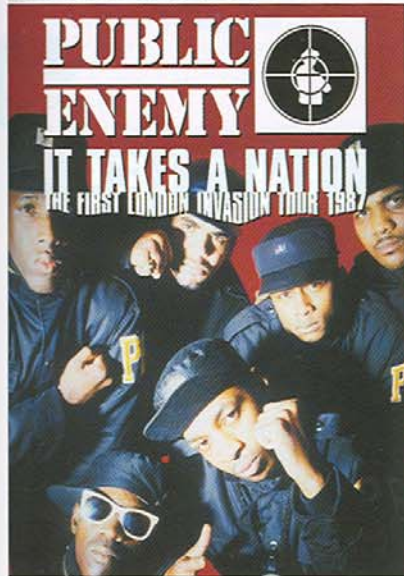
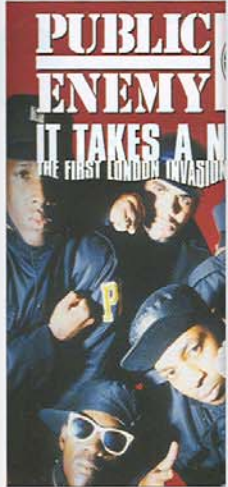

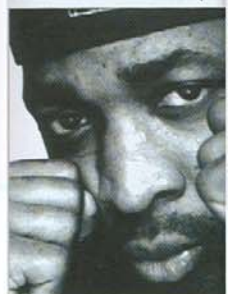

Public Enemy: It Takes A Nation

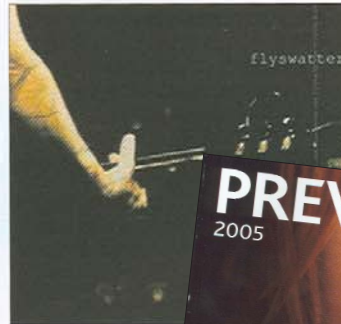

The footage dates back to the era when Public Enemy first gained worldwide recognition. Chuck D, who is joining MVD in Cannes to promote the release, said: "I'm looking forward to MIDEM being a great introduction to our the upcoming release of *It Takes A Nation*. In 1987, we boldly started to seek and build where few other rap acts had gone before."
