III, a take-no-prisoners power trio
coming at you from the City of
Brotherly Love. This very raw selftitled debut captures the energy of

the band, most notably powerhouse frontwoman Lisa Lyne Flynn, whose urgent punk-tinged vocals are exceeded only by her ability to shred on guitar.

The aptly titled "Let It Begin" gets things going and the high-octane tunes keep coming with "Revolution Blood Machine," "Die Tonight," "Fear Is Law," "Slipping Away" and "War Machine." The 12-track, 31-minute record doesn't exactly overstay its welcome, but the similar approach Workhorse III take to every song grows a little tedious at times.
