

Mick Vs. Keith: The Strange Case of Jagger & Richards

Although the Rolling Stones have clocked up 50 years together, Jagger and Richards have had to tolerate each other a fair bit longer than that. This two disc set takes a unique and previously uncharted look at the relationship and music produced by Mick & Keith during this near lifetime of close association, and in so doing, reveals much about one of the most curious partnership of the rock age.

Our Take:

I've never been a huge Rolling Stones fan beyond their greatest hits, but you can't really be a rock and roll fan without at least a cursory interest in a rock band that's been around for 50 years. **Mick Vs. Keith: The Strange Case of Jagger & Richards** is a two-disc documentary that looks at the mercurial relationship between two of the biggest rock stars in the world, and how and what it's endured over the past five decades.

Like so many unauthorized biography/documentary DVDs, the film is a somewhat interesting look at the two musicians. With no songs in the soundtracks and no new interviews with Mick and Keith, this is not like watching a fully-authorized Martin Scorsese concert film. But, with two discs and almost four hours of material, it's hard not to appreciate the effort that went into this project. There's the usual collection of ancillary footage from the band's appearances on TV and such, as well as interviews with people who have met her or worked with them, and music critics/historians. Overall, it gives a pretty comprehensive look at

one of rock's most famous duos, even if it's not a highly polished experience.
