Mix the Vibe: Quentin Harris Various artists (King Street Sounds)

Its pedigree is as New York as dance music gets, but soulful house gets little respect in its hometown nowadays. Sure, older clubbers dig it—Shelter hasn't kept going for 17 years on inertia alone—but young'uns are apt to think the sound is too light, too singsongy and just not out-there enough. Those kids could learn a thing or two from Quentin Harris. This mix, while still vocal-heavy, is dark, nasty and dangerous, aiming more for late-night sleaze than for anything remotely uplifting. The inclusion of stone-cold classics like Urban Soul's "Show Me" seals the deal.
