# The Sea and Cake Frontman Sam Prekop to Release New Solo Album

The third solo album from Sea and Cake front man Sam Prekop, Old Punch Card, hits September 7 on Thrill Jockey. But while Prekop's first two solo LPs could've been confused for Sea and Cake jams, that is apparently not the case with this one

There are no vocals or beats on the record, and only one track features guitar. Instead, *Old Punch Card* is an experimental record based on the sounds of a modular synthesizer. According to a quote from Prekop in a press release, "The most significant difference is that I've left the confines of 'song" structure." Tracklist is below.



A Gorillaz live show isn't just a live show. It's an all-encompassing multi-media affair, complete with cartoon screens and guest stars. And now they're taking that show on the road-- including to our shores-- with the "Escape to Plastic Beach" tour.



The cartoon crew have already had a big year, releasing the BNM'ed <u>Plastic Beach</u> and headlining big festivals like Glastonbury and Coachella. And now they've announced the first wave of dates on a massive world tour that will take

At this past weekend's Pitchfork Music Festival, Girls frontman Christopher Owens won every conceivable best/worst-dressed award: neon car-crash button-up, pleated highwater khakis, sequined disco socks. A friend and I agreed that all this, combined with Owens' floppy new haircut, made him look like a nerdy professor from an 80s comedy-- one who somehow thinks he's cool and who plays in a band that sounds like Devo. Anyone who can pull off an outfit like that demands your attention, especially if he's writing really good songs.

Earlier this year, Girls contributed music

gay hardcore short film called *I Want Your Love*, directed by <u>Travis Mathews</u>. More recently, Mathews sat n with Owens for a <u>revealing video interview</u> that included talk about a new Girls album (supposedly coming he end of the year! Jyeah!) and hooking up with dudes. Owens also played an acoustic version of a new Girls 2 called "Oh My Love", a fragile country track which was inspired by Dwight Yoakam and which Owens

# Nigel Godrich's *Scott Pilgrim* Score Due

Beck, Cornelius, and Dan the Automator also featured.



There is a <u>lot of news</u> about the music for the upcoming flick <u>Scott Pilgrim Vs. the World</u>. First, the <u>soundtrack</u> features new music from Beck and Broken Social Scene (as fictional bands), along with non-new tracks from people like Metric and Black Lips (as themselves). Then the <u>deluxe edition of the soundtrack</u> features a few more Beck songs. (Hear the Beck-sung version of "Summertime" over at <u>We All Want Someone to Shout For.</u>)

And now the score-- put together by Radiohead/Beck producer Nigel
Godrich-- is going to be released as well, as the Playlist reports.



Scott Pilgrim Vs. the World: Original Score Composed by Nigel Godrich boasts bits of movie music from Godrich himself, Beck, Dan the Automator, mash up artist Osymyso, and even a track with Cornelius and Beck together. Both the soundtrack and the score are out August 10, with the

movie following three days later. According to the Playlist, Broken Social Scene's Kevin Drew and Brendan Canning, Supergrass' Gaz Coombes and Danny Goffey, and Beck's father David Campbell all perform on the score as well.

Last weekend, Indiana rapper Freddie Gibbs absolutely ripped the stage at the Pitchfork Music Festival. And on August 3, Decon will release his *Str8 Killa* EP. The final track on that EP, "Oil Money", is a collaboration with a whole ton of dudes.

Texas legend <u>Bun B</u> raps on the track, as do fellow Midwestern up-and-comers Chip Tha Ripper and <u>Cool Kid</u> Chuck Inglish. One other Midwestern dude sings on the track but doesn't rap on it: <u>the Black Keys' Dan Auerbach</u>, who <u>knows something about working with rappers</u>. The whole thing works as a nice, understated slow crawl, and you can

download it from It's a Rap.
