Now, it's back as Guillermo Del Toro's Award-Winning and Visually Stunning Fantasy is now available in 4K Resolution for the first time. This complementary 4K is much more exciting to watch and the details are astounding, the film looks new! This fantasy takes place in the chaos of Civil War-era Spain. It is a masterpiece especially in High Definition! Young Ofelia is melancholy and imagines she enters a world of unimaginable cruelty when she moves in with her new stepfather, a tyrannical military officer. Armed with only her imagination, Ofelia (Ivana Baquero) discovers a mysterious labyrinth and meets a faun who sets her on a path to saving herself and her ailing mother. But soon, the lines between fantasy and reality begin to blur, and before Ofelia can turn back, she finds herself at the center of a ferocious battle between good and evil. Amazing Special Effects and a gripping performance by Ivana keeps you glued to your seat! My personal review is that this is one of Del Toro's finest work when CGI was limited at the time of filming and he has since improved with a multitude of new films that titillate your imagination to the fullest! WOW! I have never seen a more ambitious TV Show like **Doom Patrol: The Complete First Season** (Warner Bros Blu-ray and Digital) and the complimentary copy sent to me is full of surprises never seen or hit the DC Universe in a long time. Fresh, comical, horrifying, a few cuss words too, this all-punched-up show will find and get a grip on your inner Demons and has become a fan favorite since hitting the air-waves! In my own opinion this mysterious cast of characters will

intrigue your mind's eye as you discover the mysterious disappearance of Dr. Niles Caulder (The Chief) who dispenses rules for these reluctant heroes! The Doom Patrol will soon find themselves in a place they never expected to be, called to action by none other than Cyborg, who comes to them with a mission hard to refuse. Part Support Group, part Super Hero team, Part Potato Couches, the Doom Patrol is a band of super powered freaks who fight for a world that wants nothing to do with them. The naughty group disobeys the chief and visits Clovertown, Ohio where all hell breaks loose and Mr. Cyborg aka Vic Stone helps in searching for The Chief and encounters all sorts of strange creatures including an Albino Monkey. That's just the start of this powerful Series with all 15 Episodes including Deleted Scenes and co-starring Brendan Fraser.

Celebrating the 35th Anniversary of one of the most beloved horror/ comical roller-coaster films is the mischievous **Gremlins** (available on Warner Bros. Ultra 4K HG, Blu-ray Combo Pack + Digital)! It was so popular in 1994 you could hardly buy a ticket to see it. Toys of all kinds hit shelves and this was the creative work of director Joe Dante and superbly written by Chris Columbus. The effects were clever (no CGI) and it all starts when people buy new little pets called fur balls released in American Pet Shops for Christmas. Cute and cuddly, however they come with a warning, "No Bright Lights," "Once wet, they multiply," and if fed after midnight, "They transform into little horrible, devil Monsters!" Gremlins start taking over an entire town, invading a bar, singing horrible Christmas Carols while playing tricks and invade a Movie Theatre and watch Disney's "Snow White," a hilarious highlight of the film. Starring two of the most popular stars of their time, Zach Galligan and Phoebe Cates, their performances are golden! Shriek and shout and get all three shockers for a Halloween Party. I'm screaming about the creeper **Malevolence** (Arrow Blu-ray +DVD Combo Pack)! I watched the



first one on Amazon, the film proved so popular the producers made two more: **Malevolence 2: Bereavement** and **Malevolence 3: Killer!** Watch your kids carefully, the first film sets the horror! Taken from his backyard swing at the age of six, Martin Bristol was forced to witness and participate in the horrific crimes of a deranged madman. For years, Martin's whereabouts have remained a mystery... until four bank robbers, on the run from the law, meet up at an abandoned house to split up the loot. They chose the wrong house. Starring R. Brandon Johnson, Samantha Dark, Heather Magee and Kevin McKelvy as Special Agent Willam Perkins. **Malevolence** was a cult phenomenon when it was first released in 2005. It became one of Anchor Bay/Starz best-selling DVD titles of that year. **Malevolence** just received a new transfer from the original 35mm Negative, supervised by Director Stevan Mena and Cinematographer Tsuyoshi Kimoto.
