### The Sissi Collection

Just in time for your Holidays, Romy Schneider's superb Sissi 5 Disc Set Collection (Film Movement Blu-ray Classics- 1955) brings together the "Trilogy" with newly restored 2K visuals and available for the first time in BD! The Blu Ray and DVD box sets include Forever my Love, the beloved Sissi Trilogy presented in a condensed English-dubbed version, originally released by Paramount Pictures in the U.S. and highlighting the theme song written by Burt Bacharach! Romy Schneider makes an impressive starring debut in the delightful Austrian comedy Sissi. The titular heroine is a preteen 19th century lass of noble birth, who charms everyone she meets. Especially impressed is young Franz Joseph, emperor of the Hapsburg Empire. When Sissi comes of age, the emperor pursues the girl romantically, with fascinating results. Sissi was the first of a popular series of films showcasing Romy Schneider as the young Empress Elizabeth. Then came Sissi: The Young Empress: The second in a trilogy of movies about Elisabeth 'Sissi' of Austria, the film chronicles the married life

of the young empress as she tries to adjust to formal and strict life in the palace and an overbearing mother-in-law. The final installments of Sissi include: The Fateful Years of an Empress is spectacular and perfect for the entire family! In Vienna, young Austrian Empress Sissi is fatigued from the pressures of having to hold court. Though happily married to Emperor Franz Joseph, Sissi must endure the familial machinations of Franz's mother, Archduchess Sophie. Moving forward we come to Victoria in Dover! England, the 19th century. Young Victoria is crowned to be the queen of England. She aims to do her best in order to help her country prosper. However, the family and her trustful advisor, Lord Melbourne, plan marriage for her. She is to get married to a German Prince Albert. But Victoria sees her future differently and decides to leave London for a few days. She goes to Paris. On her way to France, she stays incognito in a little tavern in Dover with a baroness. There by chance she meets a handsome man and falls in love head over heels. Later, however, in very strange circumstances, it turns out



### Beside Bowie: The Mick Ronson Story

He was a legend, he was a trend setter, he was one of the Seventies Greatest Guitar Players of our time, he was Mick Ronson, now told in found recordings of David Bowie's own voice (recorded before his death), relive the excitement of The Mick Ronson Story ( MVD Visual Blu-ray (DVD) 2- Disc Set). Rockers and collectors are in for a real tune-fun treat! From Emperor Media Ltd. and acclaimed producer/director Jon Brewer, music icon David Bowie narrates this unprecedented celebration of the life and works of guitar virtuoso Mick Ronson - a rock hero virtually unknown despite his direct contribution and involvement in countless compositions, lyrics and recordings that changed the face of music forever. His humble beginnings in Hull, England underpinned the values and mod-


est, unpretentious personality of Mick Ronson, who worked with the city's council while he pursued his craft with consummate dedication. Soon word of his talent reached David Bowie, who grabbed at the chance to work with Ronson, in what would become a career-long association, alongside collaborations with other greats such as Bob Dylan, Ian Hunter, Lulu and Lou Reed. The DVD highlights Ronson's talent - not just as a skillful guitarist, but as a music arranger - especially important on the 5 Bowie/Spiders albums as well! And The Man Who Sold the World, Aladdin Sane, Hunky Dory, The Jean Genie - all were constructed with Ronson on guitar. In particular, the BD exemplifies Ronson as a producer who learned some of the ropes from Bowie producer and bassist Tony Visconti (also



interviewed for the film) who designates how he taught Ronson to score material. Sadly in 1993, while working on a solo album, Ronson passed away before receiving the recognition he so richly deserved or before taking that final bow. Now, with unprecedented access to archival backstage footage - never before released - and iconic imagery from superstar photographer Mick Rock, this fascinating and at times controversial special reveals the ultimate authentic chronicle of the career of a cornerstone of rock. Bonus interview footage from Angie Bowie, Rick Wakeman, Glen Matlock, Cherry Vanilla, Ian Hunter, David Stopps and more!

### After Image

Poland's Official Submission for Best Foreign Film is now available from Director Andrzej Wajda (FINAL FILM BEFORE HIS DEATH) that was nominated in the 89th Academy Awards and called After Image (Film Movement Blu-ray). The great Polish director Andrzej Wajda returns with this passionate biopic about avant-garde artist Wladyslaw Strzeminski (brilliantly played by Polish superstar Boguslaw Linda), who battled Stalinist orthodoxy and his own physical impairments to advance his progressive ideas about art. Also note that Director Wajda, a prestigious legendary filmmaker, won an Oscar for Lifetime Achievement, a BAFTA, Palme d'Or (Cannes), and Cesar Award,



amongst many others. He has been nominated for dozens of awards, including Golden Bears (Berlin), Palme d'Or Awards (Cannes), Golden Lions (Venice). Take note- This is an angry, vivid, passionate film, a Classic not to be missed!
