Gawk, listen and be amazed at Bent (Film Movement Classics Blu-ray- 1997), the stunning film adaptation of Martin Sherman's Award-Winning Play starring a very young Clive Owen, super-star Ian

MCKellen and Mick Jagger in drag!!!! In 1930s Berlin, homosexual Max (Clive Owen) sleeps with German officer Wolf (Nikolaj Waldau), only to see him killed by his fellow Nazis the next morning. Jagger is a singing Drag Queen who also flees the Germans just in time by burning his gowns and changing back to a man's name. The film is worthwhile just to see Jagger perform and sing suspended from a wire hoop!!! Meanwhile, fleeing with his boyfriend, Rudy (Brian Webber), the couple is eventually caught and taller Max is forced to beat his partner to death on a train to prove they have no connection. He's then sent to Dachau concentration camp and meets Horst (Lothaire Bluteau), a proud gay man also bound for the camp. Despite their harsh surroundings, (the film has many depressing moments to bear) the two fall in love. The Extras point out that many American films adapted about Jews in the 40's and 50's substituted straight Star patches on the protagonist, when actual ly, they were Gay and had a Pink Triangle on their prison clothes. Those films never implicated that Gays were severely hunted like dogs, only straight Jew families,(a shameful cover-up of the times). Though, this altered process made a taboo subject more marketable at the box office. Now the full truth is revealed in this "uplifting and life-affirming cinematic (piece of) brilliance!" Out-of-work circus performer Abel Rosenberg (David Carradine, Kill Bill) is living in poverty. When his brother commits suicide, he moves into the apartment of his cabaret singer sister-in-law (Liv Ullmann, Scenes from a Marriage), but the pair soon attract the attentions of both the police and a professor with a terrifying area of research when they start to make enquiries about his mysterious death. One of Bergman's darkest and most unlikely films, The Serpent's Egg is a hypnotic, and a "Kafkaesque tale of paranoia" in a poisoned city.
