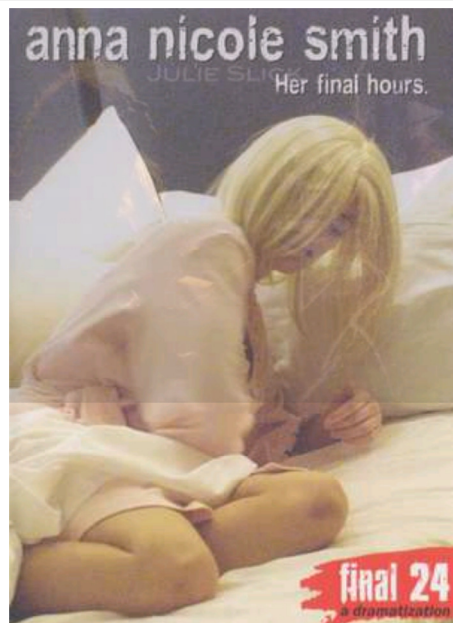
# Slick, Trout and 'Final 24' endings

Many people remember the events of April 18, 1993, when the Branch Davidians' Waco compound burned to the ground at the end of the longest siege in modern U.S. law-enforcement history. This DVD tells of the charismatic, sociopathic leader of the cult, David Koresh.

As the son of a teen mother, he had endured stepfathers and in-school harassment while growing up; but through careful manipulation and gifted oratory, had built a group of followers, most of whom died with him as the Davidians set their compound on fire rather than come out and surrender to the assault waged on them by the FBI and ATF.

This volume, like the ones above, has an actor who physically resembles its subject much more than the earlier Janis Joplin and Keith Moon volumes. The Sid Vicious volume will wrap things up next week.

**'Common Ground,' Walter Trout (Provogue Records, HHHH 1/2)**

This July 6 CD is the latest from blues guitarist/vocalist Walter Trout, who has played with lots of different people but is probably most beloved by U.S. blues backers for his tenure in John Mayall's Bluesbreakers. Since John encouraged him to start his solo career in 1989, he's been touring nearly non-stop; and this is his 20th album.

The studio band supporting Trout is truly top-notch: drum legend Kenny Aronoff (John Mellencamp, John Fogerty), New Orleans keyboard whiz Jon Cleary and bassist Hutch Hutchinson (both currently playing

with Bonnie Raitt). Producer John Porter has worked with artists from The Smiths to B.B. King.

Blues backers will want this CD, with highlights like the sincere title song, barn-burners like "Loaded Gun" and "Wrapped Up in the Blues," a snarky shuffle.
