Released on August 24, *Marvin Gaye - His Final Hours* presents a brief biography of Motown superstar Marvin Gaye and details his last day. On April 1, 1984, he was shot to death by his father.

Considered one of the most successful recording artists in the world, Marvin Gaye had experienced career ups and downs—the downs due to his cocaine addiction. When he died, he had been depressed for approximately six months, and many of those close to him believed he was suicidal.



Gaye was living with his parents (in a home he had given them) after a tiring one-year tour. There was a great deal of tension between him and his father (Marvin Gay, Sr.) over the junkies and drug dealers who were frequenting their home.








Tension and bitterness had been the hallmark of the relationship between Gaye and his father. As a child, Marvin Gaye frequently clashed with the strict disciplinarian that his father was. Marvin Gay, Sr., had made it very clear to his children that if they disrespected him, they would be in a world of trouble. He often told them, "I brought you into this world, and I can take you out." Beginning at about the age of seven, Gaye was administered regular beatings. He had a very close relationship with his mother, which was another source of his father's

irritation.

Strict discipline was not unusual for a kid born in the early 1940s, but having a father who wore women's clothing openly, and did not care what others thought was an additional burden for Gaye. His father was also a minister—I know what you're thinking, one of these things doesn't go with the others...minister, strict disciplinarian, transvestite. When Marvin Gaye was five years old he began singing gospel and people marveled at his beautiful voice. On his way to Motown, where he made his mark and his millions, he added the "e" to his last

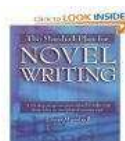
