


'Truth or Dare' with a beautiful stranger he picks up hitch hiking.

The game takes a turn for the worse and reveals the dark nature of this busty beaut and spirals Mike into a murderous tirade of vengeance which affects not only those who have wronged him, but anyone his psyche deems to have grievanced him.

The plot of this film is an interesting one, and although not terribly imaginative these days, and possibly only slightly for the time of this movie's original release it is still an intensive and quite possible scenario.

Sadly the age of this feature affects its appeal, the aficionados will appreciate its worth, but younger or less inclined viewers may see it as bland and unfulfilling.

--VIDEO

The video quality has not aged well at all. Although various scenes are of much better quality than others, the overall look is dated. I do not know exactly whether this is degradation or if the feature has always lacked this quality, but the fact of the matter is it doesn't look too great and I have to rate it on what you will be paying for if you buy this, not what it looked like back in the day.

The actual cinematography however isn't bad. Its not going to wow you, but it does work very well and shares a lot of tendencies of horror films at the time.

Special effects are a mishmash of good and bad, but generally the point that have to get across is successful.

--AUDIO

Although a low score, its based purely on the standards of today. The mixing makes the audio sound a little tinny, and the score is a bit generic of the time.

Considering the age of the piece its not particularly surprising, and once again, the people that appreciate this genre and era most will not take it too badly.



-- EXTRAS

The Extras are what surprised me most here, although most of them are basic and unfulfilling, I did quite thoroughly enjoy the 'film facts' they aren't numerous, but generous in the information and appreciation they give you about this nostalgic piece.

It may be only a small saving grace, but in a world of special features that are nothing more than trailers or shitty promos, it is a welcome addition in my opinion.

--FINAL THOUGHTS

Although I wasn't particularly a fan of this piece, being someone that grew up with horror movies I was deeply appreciative of the nostalgic feel of the film, and was guite pleased to relieve an era of horror that didn't require me to bash myself over the head with moral backdrops and overtones.
