

# Friday Night Frights: Inbred Redneck Vampires DVD Review

Straight out of Transylvania, Vampire Catherine and her brood are being chased and eliminated by a Vampire Hunter on a mission. Catherine escapes with one of her fledgling vampires and heads south to avoid the hunter, only to wind up in the little town of Backwash. Catherine decides to turn the town into a vampire army to fight for her....and hijinks ensue.

If you are familiar with no budget indie horror, you kind of know what is coming...and all of those typical things are present. Badly written and acted dialogue, bad lighting and on the spot special effects. I am fine with this as I appreciate the enthusiasm of the cast and crew and can still have fun along with them as they this poor man's version of True Blood. Ok, just kidding about the True Blood thing, Inbred Redneck Vampires, aka Bloodsucking Redneck Vampires was made in 2004, before Sookie was raking in ratings for HBO.

There is a prominant subplot featuring an interior decorator who comes to give one family, the Poissiers, a room makeover after Ma Poissier wins a contest in Bull Inseminating and Home Decorating magazine. The sterotypical gay frenchman, Jean-Claude Les Eaux, who is sent to redecorate the Poissier bathroom ends the being prominant throughout the movie and the decorating sets up for a funny conclusion.

The one thing about this film is that it tends to get sidetracked on the whole vampire plot, stepping out frequently to poke fun at the rednecks. As thes moments usually showcased Cletus, the alcoholic dwarf who is the reason to watch the movie, I didn't mind a bit. Teamed with Lil' Junior Poissier (pronounced Pisser!) Cletus is quite funny. The two start off peeping on an attractive neighbor in the shower, which leads to the interior decorator getting a good look at her husband and all three getting chased away at gunpoint. Things get even crazier with bean eating/farting montages and reach the pinnacle of redneck jokes when they play strip poker with ol' one eyed Lurlene.

Special features include a making of featurette. It is an interesting look at the cast and crew of this no budget film having fun and goofing around between takes. Also included is a blooper reel from the movie. Most of the bloopers are a bit boring, however there is a run from the frying pan to the head scene that was funny enough to watch it all. There is a gallery of trailers for 9 other films from Sub Rosa as well as the trailer for Inbred Redneck Vampires. The cover mentions a commentary track and photo gallery, however when I watched the dvd on my computer I did not see either of these options in the extras menu.

Inbred Redneck Zombies will definitely not appeal to all horror fans. For those who enjoy microbudget horror comedies with lots of politically correct gross out humor, Inbred Redneck Vampires is definitely worth a watch.
