Night of the Living Dead: Reanimated

George Romero's 1968 classic is re-envisioned in animated form by over 150 artists and animators in a monster mash-up of styles: a little primitive CGI, a little stop-motion with dolls or plasticine figures, puppets, paintings, pixilated photography and a lot of comic-book style panels and splash pages, all of them cut together to the original soundtrack of the film. A few effective images and sequences aside, it's more fan stunt rather than artistic tribute, a visual mess made with affection. Features multiple commentary tracks, interviews, panel discussions, deleted and alternate scenes and behind-the-scenes shorts among the supplements. [Close](#)
