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
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Is Sir Paul McCartney Really the 'Faul' Guy – My theory on the George Harrision secret audio tapes released

Well doesn't that peak the psyche interest, I explained again to my husband and immediately went to Google but didn't use keywords Is Paul McCartney dead, but Paul McCartney Really is Dead and up came a website dedicated to this documentary with a preview, reviews, and the order form to purchase the DVD. I must say this was probably the most eerie preview I've ever seen, more eerie then any preview or horror movie in my life, I knew at that point, I HAD to see it.

Ron was a bit more skeptical and sat and read the reviews, but being the skeptic he is right away wrote it off there was no way it could be true but that wasn't good enough for me, I wanted to watch it and I wanted to watch it NOW.

Now my husband being a bit older then me and a longer and probably a bigger (but not by much) Beatles fan then I have been over the years was difficult for him to swallow this could even BE a possibility and think what made him more reluctant to watch it, but none the less we ordered it. It was late at night, and skeptical he fell asleep half way through, not from boredom and I don't even think because he was really tired, it was to much for such a dedicated Beatles fan to swallow, he wanted to close his mind to the possibility because what we were watching was really almost indisputable especially hearing what is believed to be George Harrison narrating this urban legend and why it was a cover up, but still inconceivable.

I watched it all and after I couldn't sleep I was in disbelief and began trying to rationalize it, but every time I did in my head I would say, But...

Except for maybe Heather Mills stated during a late night interview (I believe it was Jay Leno or David Letterman) she and Paul were doing just after announcing they were getting married and I still to this day can't understand how she actually sat with a straight face and said when her and Paul met she had never in her life heard of The Beatles, heard of Paul McCartney or heard any of their music. Come on where was she living, on Mars? Even there the Martians probably know who The Beatles are. That whole relationship right from the get go was highly questionable and after you watch this documentary will make you at least think hmmm.... But ...

Ron isn't one to talk his thoughts out loud hammering on a subject to long like I do, he may briefly discuss it and move on and think to himself, research a subject quietly until he gets an answer that satisfies him but I saw something bothered him, how could it not, the possibility was to debatable not to talk it out a bit so he started to rationalize it out loud but every time he tried to, again there was still the big But ...

We pulled them out again today, The Beatles albums, and looked and studied them the way the Paul McCartney Really Is Dead documentary pointed out.

Our 13 year old daughter who never took an interest in the album collection before and not because she hadn't seen them but to her they were just big Frisbees that you put on that ancient flat spinny thing that plays music, after she finished intently watching the documentary she came into the kitchen and said 'Dad, can I look at your record collection of The Beatles?" Carefully he handed them to her and she looked through them and repeated on each album cover looking for the clues pointed out in the documentary reading through the "Magical Mystery Tour" booklet that came with it searching through "Sgt. Peppers Lonely Heart Club Band" remembering everything she heard and studied each of them she then turned and asked us, 'Why don't they make album covers anymore? They are really cool' I think they should sell them again, they are really fun to look at and has beautiful art on them."

It then came to us could this documentary be the music execs way of putting the interest of old day sales into new interest, the first installment of an elaborate plan?

How brilliant this would be of them not promoting it to the tits and creating instant media and fan frenzy about it risking people to just write it off as a ploy by the music execs for sales, and if it didn't work the money promoting it would have taken a bite out of the accounting books. This way releasing it more silently costing next to nothing if (and they know it would) it caught on would let it go viral on its own knowing full well that's how 'Social Networking' works and if it didn't, well onto Plan B and with little money lost in promotions.

I don't know if we'll ever find out maybe there will be more audio tapes or documents in the future when all the former Beatles are one day laid to rest but until then, what can either Paul McCartney or Ringo Starr really say about this or will they?
