However, the sixth song on the album *Beatles VI*, "Words Of Love," was in fact composed by Buddy Holly, who died not only on the *third* of February, 1959, but stipulated in *his* last testament that all posthumous, universal rights to his publishing catalog be granted in perpetuity to none other than JAMES PAUL McCARTNEY for the nominal fee of... *two hundred and fifteen thousand dollars* (U.S.)

3. When spoken backwards, the title of the 2006 Paul McCartney classical album *Ecce Cor Meum* is MUEM ROC ECCE.

4. Paul McCartney's first fiancée, the actress and cake decorator Jane Asher, most recently appeared in the comedy series *The Old Guys*.
