# Paul McCartney Really is Dead: The Last Testament of G. Harrison

On June 18, 2010, Paul McCartney turned 68, but the producers of this new film want people to question whether Paul is really Paul or is he a fake.

#### Backmasking

The film also goes into Backward Masking, or Backmasking, which is when an album is played backward to reveal sounds and words that are not audible when the album is played forward. In several songs, when backmasked, there seem to be revelations about the accident and Paul's death.

According to "George Harrison," John Lennon was killed because he was about to go public with the deception. MI5 stepped in to stop him by arranging for his murder. The Harrison in this film says MI5 was responsible for his stabbing and therefore he created the audio cassettes as a backup, in case they succeeded in silencing him in the future.
