We all know David Bowie's music and even though his life has been fairly public, there is a great deal that we do not know about the man. The "Rare and Unseen" series looks at various artists with just a small amount of their music. This is NOT a collection of Bowie clips as he sings. Rather this is a series of interviews. Bowie helped to bring glam rock to the forefront and he as an iconoclast as well as a composer, a lyricist, a poet and a performer.

Here we have the interview in which he admits to drug usage and he talks about his time in Berlin. We have rehearsal footage unseen until now and we have Bowie talking about Bowie. I remember well when he came onto the scene and I went to one of his concerts during his first tour. He was Ziggy Stardust then and he was unbelievable. He came in from the ceiling in a plastic bubble with red, red hair and a sequined costume to match—those were the days.

Bowie says that he is surprised that people took him seriously because he doesn't. It's quite a look into quite a man.
