The Dwarves are one of those punk bands that have been doing what they do for so long that at this point you'd be hard pressed to find someone who hasn't at least heard of them (at the TSOL show I went to last night I saw no less than two Dwarves shirts in the crowd if that's any gauge). If you're not familiar though, think The Meatmen, Turbonegro, AC/DC, early Queers... basically bands that rock hard and with front-men that don't mind playing the role of the asshole.
