Valerie Alexander as LIZ: Despite spraining her knee in a chase scene early in production, Alexander refused to delay the shoot and would go on to perform all of her owns stunts with the injury.

Glenn "Illa" Skeete as BEN: Illa wrote the two rap songs he performs in the film from bullet points given to him by Weathers. He was also given the freedom to tweak his own dialogue, something he would do in the several other films he shot with the director.

Walter Romney as STEVE: A friend of the director Romney took the role as a favor to him, he would go on to work with Weathers on several more productions.

Johnny Black as NAHUM: Black got the role through lead actress Valerie Alexander, who he was performing in a play with at the time.

Blue as HEATHER: In a recent interview Weathers said, "If I had that exact same cast from my first film to work with today I would have swapped Blue and Valerie and had Blue as my lead."

Clinton Philbert as KEVIN: In the first draft of the script this character was intended to be the lead.

Buddy Love as DAVID: Because of scheduling conflicts, Love's character was written out of the final sequence of the film.

WHY IS THIS FILM RELEVANT?

Shot in February 1996, the original House of the Damned marked the directorial debut of Sean Weathers and the first Full Circle Filmworks production.

CONTEXT

Inspired by THE RETURN OF THE LIVING DEAD and EVIL DEAD movies as well as THE TWILIGHT ZONE television series. Weathers wanted this film to be something that combined all of the things he enjoyed watching as a kid, shot with an all black cast, which is a first for a film of this genre.

PLOT SUMMARY

After the gruesome and mysterious murder of her father, Liz goes back home for answers. Only to be greeted by more questions and the horrible possibility that her mother may be the killer. Before Liz can comprehend everything going on around her, she finds that the murder was just a ruse to get her home and that she is the killer's true target. Things get

supernatural and quirky very quickly in this horror comedy. Highlights including a rapping zombie and a lesbian zombie being shoved into a closet. This film is also note worthy as being the directorial debut of [[Sean Weathers]] and it was also dedicated to his best-friend and script supervisor [[Jahvaughn Lambert]], who committed suicide before the film was finished editing.

MOTIFS

HAUNTED HOUSE - Footage of the house coming alive and things moving on their own is spread throughout the film before and/or after people are killed. This is to remind the viewer of the supernatural context of the occurrences and of Emily's evil presence, in her absence.

SYMBOLS

THE HOUSE - various exterior shots of house are shown at strategic points in the film to subconsciously have the viewer see the house as another evil character waiting to strike.

PRODUCTION NOTES

In late 1995, Weathers emailed Issa a rough outline of the script. At that point, it was just a 20 minute short. Weathers would eventually elongate it to approximately 70 pages. Weathers and Issa cast mostly their friends. The project was filmed over a month, the first week in Boston & the last few weeks at Weathers' house in Brooklyn.

TRIVIA

- · The original title of the film was HOUSE OF THE DEAD, it was changed in fear that too many films had that title.
- · The film is dedicated to Jahvaughn Lambert, Weathers' best-friend who committed suicide before the film was done editing.
- The Kevin character was initially intended to be the main character after Weathers watched Evil Dead II. This was changed in the final draft as Weathers felt that people would not be as interested in a man-in-peril formula as they would a woman.
- · In the climactic fight in the cellar with Liz and Heather, the residue from the dirt ground was so bad that the camera men where rotated in-between takes.
 - · The statement that starts the film off. "Due to my

strong personal convictions, I wish to stress that this film in no way endorses a belief in the occult." Was taken directly from Michael Jackson's thriller video.
