WHY IS THIS MOVIE RELEVANT?

DISCLAIMER: Due to the graphic nature of the film. It was investigated by the NYPD & FBI & thought to be a "snuff-film." Although it was never proven the case is still considered to be open.

CONTEXT

After watching what he was told by friends was the most vile rape film ever done "I Spit on Your Grave," Sean Weathers felt his friends didn't know what vile was. Prompting him to make a film that for better or worse, would set a new standard.

PLOT SUMMARY

Prepare to be dropped 1,000,000 feet right into the center of Hell for the longest, nastiest, and most brutal gang-rape in motion-picture history. The Bedford-Stuyvesant neighborhood of Brooklyn, New York was once called "Do or Die Bed Stuy," but in recent years it has been gentrified by yuppies. Is Bed-Stuy a neighborhood on the rise? Or is it a Venus fly trap?

In the U.S., 1.3 women are raped every minute. That's 78 rapes per hour. 1 out of every 3 American women will be raped in her lifetime. There are 2 million rapes in the U.S. per year... This is the story of 1 of them.

PRODUCTION NOTES

In the fall 1997, one year after his first film "House of the Damned," Sean Weathers set out to complete his 2nd film, "Dirty Deeds," a rape-revenge film. After doing extensive research on this sub-genre one title kept coming up "I Spit on Your Grave," after mentioning it to friends, cast, crew, and local video store owners, and hearing of the long, gritty, realistic, brutal, violent, humiliating, sadistic, and excruciating to watch rape scene. He decided to watch it, upon viewing it, Weathers felt the film did not live up too

it's reputation. Prompting him to discard his original script which was plot heavy, recast and start from scratch with a single goal of bringing to the screen the most infamous film ever made. After several months of rewrites and recasting and three emotionally draining weeks of shooting, for better or for worse, by the end of the summer of 1998 his mission was accomplished with the film now known as "They All Must Die!." Too gut-wrenching for film festivals and screening venues, and with no distributor wanting to touch it because of the legal issues surrounding its, "snuff film," allegations and subsequent investigation by the NYPD & FBI, the film had been shelved for over 13 years. Until the fall 2011 against the wishes of the director himself, the film was released by Music Video Distributors (MVD) through a contract loophole, as MVD hopes to capitalize on the controversy surrounding the film.

TRIVIA

- To get more intensity out of the rape scene it was the first scene shot, and the lead actress was kept away from the other actors until it was time to shoot the scene.
- · Tension on set grew so high between the actor who played Nissan and the lead actress, that the director Sean Weathers made them reshoot their part of the rape scene on the last day in hopes to capture that tension on camera.

MOTIFS

WENDY'S NEW BOOK - Wendy's decision to write a book on "the struggle of black men," is the reason she moves to Bed-Stuy. It's the reason Stan, a successful black man, feels in his mind that they belong together and it's how the thugs justify there attacks on her.

FISH OUT OF WATER - Wendy born into money, in the right family, with the right skin color, in the right environment, with the right education and under the right circumstances, was breed to succeed. This is contrasted by the thugs who were born into poverty, in broken homes, with the wrong skin color, in the wrong environment and with little to no education, were breed to fail. Her entering Bedstuy represents a class, social, economical, educational and racial clash.

SYMBOLS

JESUS SAVES - African religions were of spirit, not of doctrine, however Africans who were brought to America in the early 1600s as slaves eventually converted to Christianity. Though the reasons for their conversion is debatable. The zoom shot on the "Jesus saves" graffiti after we see the thugs are alive and they get away with the rape is symbolic of the racial, religious, educational, class and sexual tension between blacks and whites during and since slavery in the U.S.

RISING ACTION

Wendy rejects Nissan in front of his friends for a second time. This time more emphatically, to which his friends let him know. He then guarantees he'll get the last laugh on her.

CLIMAX

The thugs get into Wendy's apartment and then methodically take their time sexually assaulting, torturing and humiliating her.

FALLING ACTION

Wendy's bloody revenge turns out to be nothing but a dream. When she wakes from it she is assaulted again, this time by Stan Blackman.

DÉNOUEMENT

The next day Wendy is tied up in bed and is doomed to become Stan's sex slave, while the thugs are hanging out and having a laugh about their wild night.
