
The other side of Ike and Tina Turner

Rock photographer Bob Gruen's doc on Ike and Tina Turner — "Ike & Tina: On the Road 1971-72" — shows a different side of the couple than the 1993 film "What's Love Got to Do With It."

Years ago, Gruen went on tour with the Turners to capture behind-the-scenes footage including Tina cooking for her kids and showing back-up dancers The Ikettes how to move. Gruen learned why the couple broke up, but also why they were together for 20 years.

"I think that 'What's Love Got to Do With It?' could have been subtitled, 'What happens to a good man who takes too many drugs,'" he mused. His film premieres Thursday at the CBGB Music & Film Festival.
