series hosted by Mitch Pileggi (Walter Skinner on "The X-Files"). A welcome bonus is the inclusion of two documentaries that inspired "In Search Of...," "Ancient Astronauts" and "Ancient Mysteries," hosted by Rod Serling. He passed before the series began shooting, so Nimoy stepped in, an excellent choice.

"THE POINT"



In case it flew under your radar, let us point out that Harry Nilsson's absolutely delightful 1971 animated fable has been released in a "definitive collectors edition. The tale of Oblio, the only roundheaded denizen of a land where everybody, and everything, has a point, is narrated by Ringo Starr. Nilsson himself wrote and sings the charming, harmony-laden pop songs, such as "Me and Mv Arrow' and "Are You Sleeping." The endearing animation was created by Academy Award winner Fred Wolf. All ages will appreciate this timeless lesson in the absurdity of prejudice.

"COLOR ME OBSESSED: A FILM ABOUT THE REPLACEMENTS"

Even though you essentially won't see or hear the band itself at all in this reverential, bold, two-hour documentary, you'll get a clear picture of The Replacements' lasting impact. Fervent testimonials from insightful fans, including many musicians, such as members of Husker Du, The Decemberists, Babes in Toyland, Archers of Loaf and Goo Goo Dolls, as well as funnymen George Wendt, Dave Foley and Tom

Arnold, underscore the '80s Minnesota indie punk-pop band's unique place in rock history. Colorful anecdotes about band members, particularly Paul Westerberg and Bob Stinson, are highly entertaining. The two-disc set includes six hours of extras, including deleted scenes, interviews and commentaries (not by the band, of course!)

CDs

PAMELA HINES - "3.2.1."

In an intimate approach, pianist/arranger/composer Hines performs in trio, duo and solo settings. Hence the title , "3.2.1." She's joined on various tracks by bassist David Clark and drummer Yoron Israel. Hines deftly captures an array of moods, adding her own sensitive touch to songs composed by or associated with the legendary Bill Evans. Highlights include a lively "34 Skidoo," the longing "B Minor Waltz" and a pensive "If You Could See Me Now."

BELL GARDENS - "FULL SUNDOWN ASSEMBLY"

This sumptuous, complex indie pop, basking in warm harmonies, is instantly inviting and lastingly layered. The band's core is formed by Kenneth James Gibson and Brian McBride, who have obviously been influenced by another Brian... Wilson. Dreamy and trippy, tracks like "Nowhere" and "Through The Rain" are endlessly entrancing. There's a uniquely eerie beauty to the band's soundscapes.

STEVIE RAY VAUGHAN AND DOUBLE TROUBLE - "TEXAS FLOOD"

Sony Legacy honors the 30th anniversary of Stevie Ray Vaughan's explosive album debut with this deluxe new two-disc set. The original 1983 rock-blues release earned a couple of Grammy nominations. In addition to dynamic Vaughan originals like "Pride and Joy" and "Love Struck Baby," the album included powerhouse covers of tunes associated with Howlin' Wolf, Buddy Guy and The Isley Brothers. The second disc provides an hour-long set, previously unavailable, recorded at Ripley's Music Hall in Philadelphia for radio broadcast. Throughout, Vaughan's fiery guitar work proves riveting.

ELVIS PRESLEY - "ALOHA FROM HAWAII VIA SATELLITE: LEGACY EDITION"

It's January, 1973. And Elvis is still very much in his prime. During these historic performances in Hawaii, broadcast throughout the world via satellite, he's brimming with energy and kingly grandeur, which is offset by his disarming, self-deprecating sense of humor. Presley sizzles on such rockers as "Burning Love." But at this point in his career, he was most impressive building the melodrama in such epic ballads as "You Gave Me A Mountain." This new 40th anniversary double-disc release gives you the original album, plus a completely remixed version of the 1988 CD, "The Alternate Aloha." That one includes bonus tracks such as "Early Morning Rain," "Blue Hawaii" and "Hawaiian Wedding Song."

FOXTAILS BRIGADE - "TIME IS PASSED"

Transcendent, dreamlike, shimmering. The San Francisco indie chamber pop band makes music that truly transports the listener. Wintry lyrical themes are presented with warmth and charm. It's alternate holiday music delivered with idiosyncratic wit. At the forefront is Laura Weinbach's gently gorgeous, girlish voice. She also weaves entrancing harmonies. The imaginative, understated instrumentation enhances the moods, but never intrudes. Anton Patzner, who plays violin, viola and guitar on the record, has done an impeccable job of producing. The Brigade borrows knowingly from the pleasures of classical, jazz and vintage pop, as well as expressing the band's more contemporary sensibilities. "Time Is Passed" is a timeless marvel.
