
Zombie Undead

Our Take:

This movie is about the search for relatives in a hospital by Sarah (Ruth King) and Jay (Kris Tearse) during a zombie epidemic. This independent zombie movie bypasses the George Romero style of victims being disembowled, but the zombies are slow moving, which is the way it should be. There are a few scenes of people getting attacked, but there is no blood or guts shown during them. It looks like director Rhys Davies didn't have enough money in the budget for it or just didn't want it.

Tearse, who also wrote the screenplay, gives the movies top three characters (Sarah, Jay, and Steve) enough heart and soul that you root from them to make it to the end of the movie.

There are funny moments throughout the movie like seeing a doctor use a lighter to check to see if a patient has a concusion instead of their normal pen light and seeing a zombie victim blink in a scene. A patient is giving a shot a la **Pulp Fiction**.
