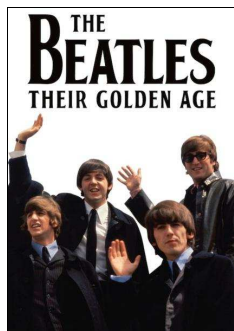

This great documentary, The Beatles, Their Golden Age, is a nostalgic look back at all the events of that time. The magic but also the pandemonium of Beatlemania period as wild fans and their films and interviews with each member of the Fab 4 will be discussed.

**Comments**

Utterly annoying is the way of the reading of the text by the author. Once there is no original sound clips are available leutert Les Krantz the facts together. Is understandable because of the rights but it's the wrong songs at the wrong times. Songs from 1967 at a scene from 1964 is not really strong.

The DVD is produced in the United States and perhaps so I have no Dutch subtitles on this DVD can discover.

Ten years Beatles always plays in one hour stop. official Anthology series is much better made and if possible, see the "director's cut" of the Beatles Anthology series if you want to view history.
