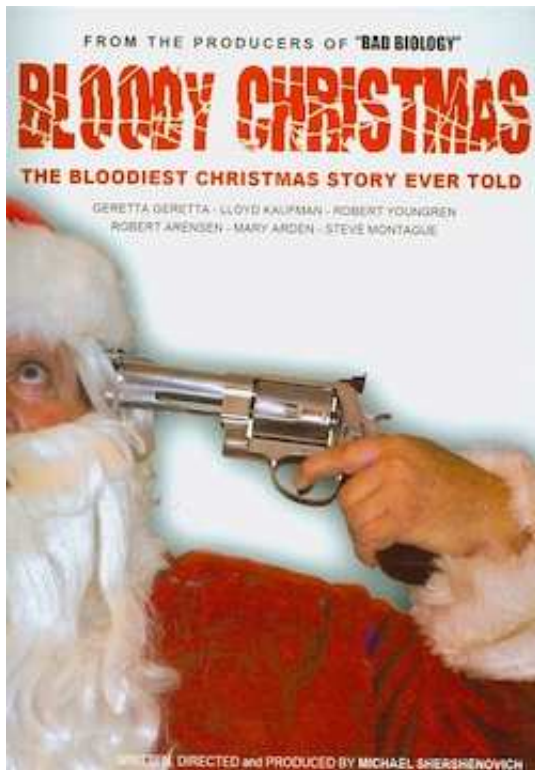


Bloody Christmas
