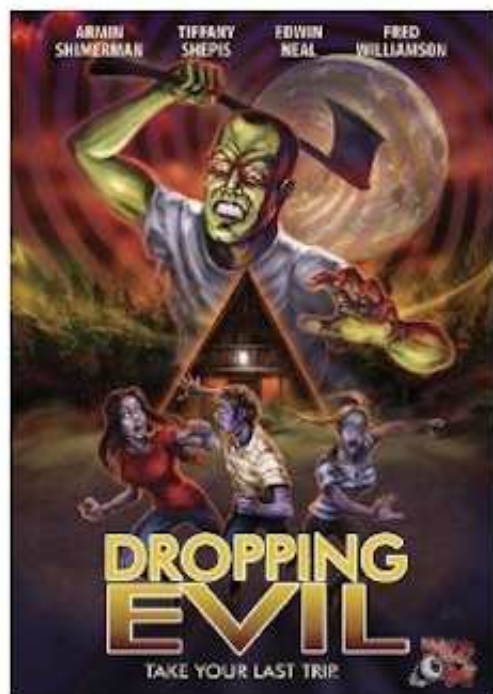


Dropping Evil
