DIO - Dream Evil: 'Dream Evil' was originally released in 1987 and is the 4th album to be released by Dio. UMC have released this metal album in its entirety and with it comes a bonus CD with the vast majority of bonus tracks taken from what I presume is Monsters Of Rock in 1987. While I like Dio by the time this album was recorded you knew what to expect and this album is proof of that. There aren't really any songs that grab you by the throat. However this isn't a bad album and tracks such as 'Night People', 'As The Fools Sailed Away' and 'I Could Have Been A Dreamer' are well worth a listen. This album is really for fans of Dio and 80's metal fans only. 7/10
