Antiviral

Also new this week from IFC Films is *Antiviral*, a twisted look at the obsession of celebrities by writer/director Brandon Cronenberg.

This is the debut feature by the son of director David Cronenberg, and the film definitely has the same pedigree.

Syd March (Caleb Landry Jones) works at a clinic that sells injections of live viruses harvested from sick celebrities to obsessed fans.

Syd makes more money on the side by selling illegal samples of the viruses to piracy groups, by smuggling them inside of his own body by injecting himself with viruses.

After he injects himself with an exotic new disease from a superstar (she dies from it shortly afterward), Syd finds himself in a race to uncover the mystery surrounding her death, before he too meets a similar fate.

Antiviral (which also stars Malcolm McDowell) is not your average science fiction medical story and is a whole different kind of Frankenstein.

Place Beyond the Pines

Ryan Gosling, Ray Liotta and Bradley Cooper star in *The Place Beyond the Pines* (Universal) an ambitious drama that is a departure from the normal cops versus crime movie.

Told in three acts (it is three stories interwoven) it mostly centers on Gosling, a stunt motorcyclist who quits the business to become a darling bank robber on bike (part of the reason of the life of crime is having an infant son to support). He finds himself at odds with cop Cooper, who has his own problems and also has a son.

Years later, both sons meet, become friends and have their own confrontation.

The Place Beyond the Pines doesn't always work,

but at times is nearly brilliant.

The film is available in standard DVD and Blu-ray formats, the combo pack includes the Blu-ray disc, DVD and digital copy, as well as bonus features (deleted, extended scenes, feature commentary etc.).

Charlie Chan Collection

Before there was a Colombo or a Jessica Fletcher (**Murder, She Wrote**), there was Charlie Chan.

The legendary master of crime was solving mysteries as early as 1926 on film, when the first of more than 48 Charlie Chan films was made.

Warner Bros. Home Entertainment has just released a 4-disc set containing four films in a single collection, starting with **Shadows over Chinatown**, a 1946 film starring Sidney Toler. Toler, took over the role of Chan from Warner Oland, who made 16 films as the detective, beginning in 1931.

In "Shadows," Charlie is on a murder case in San Francisco, when he uncovers a murder gang benefiting from the life insurance of the dead.

In **Docks of New Orleans** (1948), Roland Winters takes over the Chan role and Charlie investigates the demise of a New Orleans chemical company magnate. More deaths follow.

Shanghai Chest (also with Winters), Charlie is back in San Francisco on the trail of a serial killer, who is already believed to be deceased.

Finally, in **The Golden Eye**, Charlie (Winters again) is in Arizona where a gold mine is at the center of some very sinister goings-on.

All four films are making their DVD debut and have been newly remastered.

Upcoming

The approaching 50th anniversary of the assassination of John F. Kennedy has revived public interest in this mysterious and controversial topic. MVD Entertainment Group has announced three new documentaries from *The Shocking Truth* series via

Bruder Releasing Inc (BRI). These films contain the results of a 10 year private unbiased investigation: **1 Shot JFK, Confessions From The Grassy Knoll, and Spooks, Hoods & JFK.**

1 Shot JFK: The Shocking Truth shows the meticulous research behind the investigation, the challenges in getting this story out to the public and the shocking confession of the man who shot JFK. Private Investigator, Joe West, launched an investigation to find the true killers of President John F. Kennedy. Secretly tipped off by FBI agent Zack Shelton, West's investigation led to a convict named James E. Files, who confessed to being the shooter on the infamous grassy knoll on November 22, 1963. He also implicated organized crime members, Charles Nicoletti, Johnny Roselli, and Sam Giancana.

Confessions From The Grassy Knoll: The Shocking Truth presents an investigation into the story of a man who confessed to firing the fatal shot from the Grassy Knoll in Dealey Plaza, Dallas Texas on November 22nd, 1963. In this in-depth documentary, FBI Agents completely re-examine the assassination.

In Spooks, Hoods & JFK: The Shocking Truth CIA contract agent and underworld figure, the late Chauncey Holt, recounts his participation in deep cover black operations run by the intelligence community during the height of the Cold War.

Holt carefully connects how these "black ops" were turned against JFK leading up to his assassination in 1963. Agents and proxies who did the bidding of the 'shadow government' are unmasked for the first time. The Secret Government's unseen hand in the coup is laid bare by a private assassination paper trail that has never surfaced until now.

More than 50 years after it premiered on the ABC network, the variety shows **Here's Edie** and **The Edie Adams Show** (www.edieadams.com) are set for release

on DVD and digital formats. This is the first time either television show has been seen in any format since its original broadcast more than a half a century ago.

Additional guests include Allan Sherman, Spike Jones, Peter Falk, Sir Michael Redgrave, Zsa Zsa Gabor, Buddy Hackett and more.

Behind the Candelabra One of the most honored films at the recent Emmy Awards nominations, HBO's **Behind the Candelabra**, comes to Blu-ray/DVD Sept. 17.
