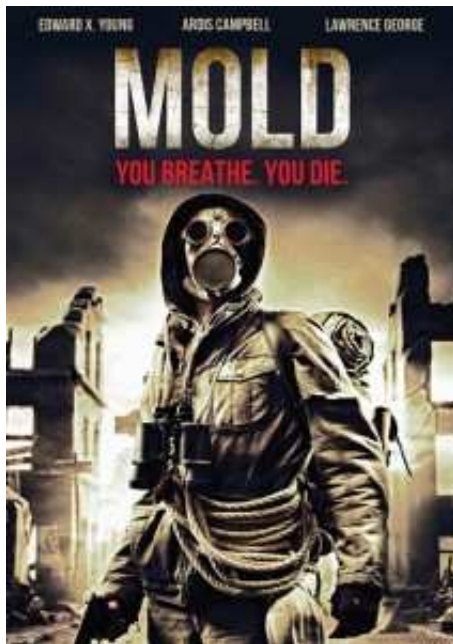


MOLD!

Mold is a glorious, goeey and hilarious tribute to 1980s style horror and science fiction classics like **Night of the Creeps** and **Street Trash**.

Our Take:

Mold! is a unique, very schlocky, yet mildly entertaining entry into the horror genre. Overall, the writing wasn't great, but from a film like this, you don't really expect a literary masterpiece. There did manage to be one gem of a line, so awesome in its ridiculousness, which was said by a Colonel, after a Doctor comments on his cigar, "If I can survive a knife fight with a Cambodian Mountain Jaguar, then this little cigar ain't got a chance" (in this sentence, he pronounces cigar, like see-gar). The acting is really nothing special either, none of the performances were really anything memorable, but once again, what do you expect from a film like this.

The production quality is not very good, the practical effects, as well as the computer effects were not very good, and the quality of the film itself left something to be desired. Besides clips from stock footage of Reagan speeches, and a few lines of dialogue, the 80's setting is non-existent, this film could have taken place at any time.
