

Worse Than Wolves (Aggronautix)

Worse Than Wolves, however, is frustratingly short with only six tracks. As a result there is little fat on this one, with each song just as solid as the next, earning its spot on the album. There is also a little more melody in these songs, but the rawness that makes up the core of their sound is still there. It was that rawness that made them stick out on the Pop Disaster Tour with Green Day and Blink 182, giving the tour a shot of badly-needed punk rock credibility.

The band, last seen by most in the music documentary "Riding in Vans With Boys" (chronicling that tour), never actually called it quits. In fact, they spent the last 10 years playing shows here and there. Apparently, it just took them a very, very long time to find their way back into the studio.
