

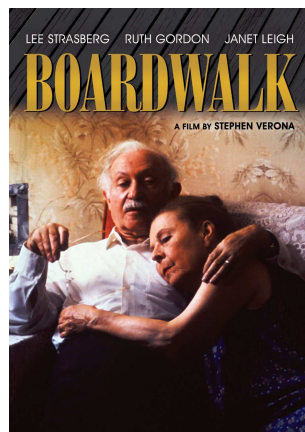


Shout! Factory / Released 3/25/14
