Sometimes the title says it all, like when you call your movie Cockneys vs. Zombies (Shout Factory); if you want to knowledgeably complain about the eventual remake of Hidden in the Woods (Artsploitation Films), check out the creepy Chilean original first; since Eli Roth keeps dragging his feet on making the Thanksgiving movie he produced as a fake trailer forGrindhouse, the void is filled with Thankskilling 3 (MVD Visual), a violent lark featuring puppets and a talking pumpkin pie, but no part two, since it's a direct sequel to 2009'sThankskilling; it never got the praise of Night or Dawn, but George A. Romero's Day of the Dead (Shout Factory) gets its HD moment in a new edition; and fans of horror anthologies won't want to miss V/H/S/2 (Magnolia Home Entertainment), featuring vignettes from some of today's leading scare meisters.
