

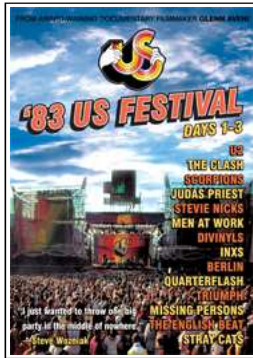

I remember 1983 like it was yesterday... Well maybe not, I was only thirteen that year. I may not remember 1983 all that well but I do remember The US Festival. In case you didn't know the US in US Festival is an acronym for "Unite Us in Song". This festival was four day celebration of music and culture in San Bernadino, CA. Steve Wozniak (formerly of Apple Computers) financed this whole festival (and it wasn't cheap) and it was worth every penny he paid. What made this festival unique was that each day of the festival was geared toward one genre of music. Day one was New Wave, day two was Heavy Metal, day three was Rock and day four was Country. Recently MVD Visual released a DVD by filmmaker Glenn Aveni entitled *'83 US Festival Days 1 – 3*.

The DVD is a highlight DVD, if you will, of the three rock related days. It clocks in at 136 minutes and features performances by INXS, The Clash, Judas Priest, Scorpions, Triumph and U2 to name a few. Some of the highlights include U2's performance of "Sunday Bloody Sunday", Mick Jones' final performance with the Clash, Triumph's legendary performances of "Magic Power", "Lay It On the Line", "Fight the Good Fight" and "A World Of Fantasy". Also included are interviews of Steve Wozniak, former and MTV VJ Mark Goodman.

'83 US Festival Days 1 – 3 is a great trip down memory lane. I remember watching it on MTV as a young teenager and it is just as exciting to watch today as it was back in the day. This is the ONLY Unuson sanctioned official release of the US Festival 1983. This DVD is highly recommended. The production is superior, the footage is top notch and it is just a plain fun DVD to watch.
